CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is an approach to the religious formation for children. It is a program that follows Catholic doctrine and is deeply rooted in the Bible and the liturgy of the Church. The goal of the Good Shepherd program is to bring children into a closer relationship with God as it focuses on their spiritual development.

The place where the children come to gather is called and "Atrium". In this calming and tranquil setting, the Catechist assists the children, as they are being lead by God. The children have their own private time to "work", which consists of prayer, singing, and working with church and biblical materials. Also, the children participate in art activities and learn how to take care of this sacred environment. The Atrium experience allows children to meditate and ponder in a prayerful setting which guides them into a deep and rich relationship with God as it nurtures the mind, heart and soul.
